1. The Word of God is a <u>seed</u> constantly broadcast on four distinct soils (Luke 8:4-15)
 The Pathway (vv.5, 12) The Rocky Soil (vv.6, 13) The Thorny Soil (vv.7, 14) The Good Soil (vv.8, 15)
2. The Word of God is a that will one day expose the thoughts of every human heart (vv.16-18)
3. The Word of God is a that reveals your spiritual pedigree (vv.19-21)

- 1. In the parable of the lamp, what does the lit lamp represent?
 - a. What does it mean to cover the lamp with a jar or put it under a bed?
 - b. What does putting the lamp on a stand represent?
 - c. How does this parable relate to the parable of the sower in the preceding verses (Luke 8:4-15)?
- 2. In verse 17, the Lord speaks about hidden things being made manifest and secrets coming to light.
 - a. Does the lamp represent the hidden secret, or does it reveal the hidden secret? Please explain.
 - b. In the parable of the sower, is there anyone who has a secret to hide? Please explain.
 - c. Is Jesus hiding his word by using parables? (See verse 10) Please explain.
- 3. In verse 18, Jesus warns his listeners to "take care then how you hear," implying that the need for care has been demonstrated in the preceding verses.
 - a. Is this warning addressed to someone who might be trying to hide a secret lamp? Please explain.
 - b. Is this warning addressed to those who have just heard the two preceding parables? (See verse 10) Please explain.
 - c. Does this warning apply to you? Why or why not?
 - d. In the parable of the sower, the seed was the word of God.
 - (1). What are these parables?
 - (2). Have you heard them before?
 - (3). How have you listened to them?
 - (4). What did you hear?

- 4. Why do you think Jesus' mother and brothers were trying to see him while he was teaching a crowd in verses 19-20? (See Mark 3:20-31)
 - a. Why weren't they part of the crowd?
 - b. In the parables of the sower and the lamp, where do you think Jesus' physical mother and brothers fit in?
 - c. Where do those Jesus claims as his mother and brothers fit in these parables?
