Discussion Questions:

Read: Matthew 25:14-29; Romans 12:1; Proverbs 22:13

What do you love to do and excel at? Or put another way, are you receiving compliments for something you do? What is it?

In what ways are you using the talents God has given you? In what ways have you hidden or wasted the talents God has given you? In what ways have you battled fear of failure that has caused you to be lazy or wasteful with your God-given talents?

In what ways has God stirred your heart with a zeal for something to work towards in the days ahead (read Exodus 35:26 & Isaiah 45:13)? In what ways can you develop the gifts He has given you to increase them from a 0-5 or 5-10 or 10-20?

Think about difficult seasons where you were "hemmed" in. What are some of the creative ways God worked through you when your work wasn't at the same capacity as before?

Read: Matthew 25:1-13; Ephesians 2:10; Ephesians 5:16

In what ways do you prepare for the future physically in your home? In what ways do you prepare for the future spiritually in your home? In what ways does it look like to not be prepared physically? In what ways does it look like to not be prepared spiritually?

What are ways in which you can bless or encourage others by wise management and willing work?

During times of delay or waiting for God to act, what has been your response? Have you let your "lamp go out"? In what ways have you resorted to "escapism" or laziness?

There may be seasons of busyness and of rest, seasons of joy and of hurt, or seasons of being available or "hemmed" in. It is not sinful to go through these changes, but it is wrong to not be stewards in each season.
