Please read Luke 8:26-39.

- 1. The possessed man from our text refers to Jesus as "Son of the Most High God" in verse 28.
 - a. Do you think that it is significant that the disciples have just asked, "Who is this that he commands even winds and water and they obey him?" Please explain your answer.
 - b. How did the man know that Jesus was the Son of God?
- 2. The man asks Jesus "What have you to do with me?"
 - a. Does the fact that Jesus is the Son of the Most High God imply an answer to that question? Why or why not?
 - b. Why did the man think that Jesus would torment him?
 - c. Did Jesus command the unclean spirit to come out from him before or after the man cried out? Please explain.
 - d. Were the demons able to resist the command of Jesus? Please explain your answer.
- 3. There is no other account in the Gospels of Jesus engaging in a dialog with demons.
 - a. When Jesus asks the man his name, is he speaking to the demons, or to the man himself? Please explain.
 - b. Is the answer given, "Legion" from the man or the demons? Please explain.
- 4. There was a herd of pigs in the area. Jews do not eat pigs.
 - a. Do you think the owners of the herd were Jews or Gentiles? Please explain your answer.
 - b. Why did the demons want to enter the pigs? (See 2 Peter 2:4)
 - c. Is there something appropriate about swine as the dwelling place for demons? Please explain.
 - d. Is the drowning of the pigs after the exorcism in any way connected with the life of the man prior to the exorcism? Why or why not?
 - e. Did the demons get what they wanted? Please explain.
- 5. What do you think the Gerasenes were afraid of?
 - a. Why did this fear prompt them to ask Jesus to leave?
 - b. Why didn't the man from whom the demons had gone share their fear?

- c. Why does Jesus grant the request of the demons, but decline the request of the man?
- 6. Jesus tells the man to "declare how much God has done for you."
 - a. How does the man alter this message?

 - b. What does this imply about his understanding of who Jesus is?c. What does this imply about the answer to the disciples' question in verse 25?
