It consists of seven questions. Similar in many ways to "The Swedish Method" we've often used in our groups, the "Secret Sauce" approach is a wonderfully faithful and fruitful way to study Scripture. The Law

- 1. What does this passage say about God?
- 2. What does this passage say about people?
- 3. Therefore, according to this passage, what should I do?
- 4. Let's be honest: How do I fail to do what this passage says I ought to do?

The Gospel

- 5. How has Christ perfectly done what this passage requires?
- 6. How is Christ's death sufficient and satisfactory for my failure to do what this passage requires?
- 7. How does Christ's resurrection empower me to live as this passage suggests?
- 8. As a Christian, indwelt by the Holy Spirit as the Gospel promises, what will I now do?
